

IDENTIFICATION PROTOCOL

Corresponds with Requirement 5.2

Identification procedures refer to hot-iron or freeze branding, tattooing, or microchipping.
The identification method(s) used at this facility include:
Identification methods used are conducted in a way to minimize stress and pain. Steps taken to minimize horse stress include:
(e.g., providing sedation, analgesia, and local anesthesia during the identification procedure. Steps taken to minimize pain include:
(e.g., administering a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug as advised and prescribed by a veterinarian).
If branding is a method used:
• Horses are never branded on the jaw or cheek.
Horses are never branded when wet.
 Horses are monitored daily after they underdo identification procedures to ensure no complications after the process. In the event of complications, a veterinarian is contacted, as needed.
