## **Registered Coach Status**

## **IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW**

- ALL required forms, templates, documents, and links are available in each step of your application once you have purchased a Coach Status from your MyEC
- EC Sport License holders can preview the documents in ECampus by selecting the Resource Tab
- Candidate must be minimum 16 years of age.
- PTSO and EC Sport License must be current.
- \$80 enrollment fee for Registered Coach Status can be paid online via **MyEC** when purchasing Coach Status.
- Special rates for insurance and first aid courses are available through EC's valued partnerships with Henry Equestrian and St. John's Ambulance
- EC's Concussion Awareness and Fostering Healthy Equestrian Environment online courses are free with the purchase of Coach Status and must be completed before purchasing a Sport License

1.	Equestrian Canada Screening Disclosure
	The screening disclosure supports EC's commitment to create a safe, welcoming, and inclusive environment for all participants. It is updated annually
	upon renewal of your Coach Status and any changes must be noted.
	If you have lived outside of Canada for more than 6 consecutive months in the last 10 years, international screening is required. Additional fees will apply
	when international screening is initiated.
	Legislation in certain countries may require a police certificate or a certificate of good conduct from the appropriate authorities within the
	country(ies) of residence. Additional costs are incurred by the candidate.
2.	Canadian Criminal Record Check
	EC provides a free link through Sterling Backcheck to conduct this criminal background search. It includes a Criminal Record Check within the RCMP
	National Repository of Criminal Records and a Local Police Information check.
	If you are under 18, two character references must be completed instead.
3.	Vulnerable Sector Search (VSS)
	This search differs from a Criminal Record Check as it searches within a closed National offenders database. It can only be completed through your local
	police detachment.
	OR
	Vulnerable Sector Search Acknowledgement (VSSA) if you were born after February 28, 1986
	If you are under the age of 18, two character references must be completed instead.

		One (1) EC Letter of Reference must be provided by one of the following.
		<ul> <li>Employer (Equine Industry) - current or within the past 3 years</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>Students/Athletes or their parent/guarding - current or within the past 3 years</li> </ul>
		- Co-workers - coaches working with you within your current coaching setting or who have worked with you in the past 3 years.
		The person providing the reference must be the age of majority in your province/territory of residence and must not be an immediate family member.
5	5.	Standard First Aid CPR Level C
		Certification must be from a Canadian provider, recognized by Occupational Health & Safety standards in your province of residence.
		QUEBEC ONLY: CNESST Cardio-Secours/DEA/SA L.SH course (A+) 16 hours

8	3.	EC Certificate of Insurance
		Minimum Required Coverages:
		– \$2,000,000 Commercial General Liability
		<ul> <li>\$100,000 Professional Liability Insurance</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>Equestrian Canada (EC) and your Provincial/Territorial Equestrian Association (PTSO) must be named as additional insured AND</li> </ul>
		<ul> <li>Waiver of subrogation in favor of EC and your PTSO</li> </ul>
		If you are an employee of a facility
		An EC Waiver of Insurance and Acknowledgment of Risks Form and an EC Certificate of Insurance from the employer is required.
